ORDER

The petitioner-in-person had filed an application seeking direction that the 'garnishee' - Director, Directorate of Storage, West Bengal, be directed to furnish the full details of the amounts lying in different heads, such as provident fund, gratuity, insurance etc. to the credit of the deceased Nirmal Chakraborty. The trial court and High Court declined to issue such directions stating that the Director was not a party to the petition.
