O R D E R

1. This Court on 13.02.2026 passed the following order:

"...

2. The present Miscellaneous Application is filed by the applicant primarily for release of the amounts, lying with the UCO Bank, Supreme Court Premises and Post Office, Supreme Court Premises as directed by this Court in the aforesaid judgment. In view of the fact that the applicant has attained majority, he will be entitled to withdraw the said amounts. Ordered accordingly.

3. We direct the concerned Registrar to facilitate withdrawal of the amounts to the applicant upon due identification and upon furnishing of proof of majority.

4. The IA No. 11069/2026 and Miscellaneous Application stands disposed of."

2. We have perused the Office Report dated 24.03.2026. As per the Office Report, there is discrepancy in the spelling of the respondent no. 1's name. Apart from that, Office Report further reflect that there is another amount with respect to Master Rishabh

Sharma which is lying with the Bank of Maharashtra which is in addition to the amount directed to be released as per order dated 13.02.2026.

3. Learned counsel appearing for the respondent no. 1 submits that his actual name is Mr. Reshav Sharma as depicted in the documents (viz. Aadhar Card and Bank Account) and not which is reflected in the paper books (i.e., Master Rishabh Sharma) and prays that the amount be released in his favour. He further prays that since Master Rishabh Sharma (now major) is visually impaired, he may be permitted to accompany with her mother who is his natural guardian.

4. In view of above, we direct that upon Master Rishabh (now major) accompanied by his mother, appearing and producing the necessary documents evidencing his correct name and address, the concerned Registrar (Judicial) may release the amount including the amount lying with Bank of Maharashtra after due verification.

5. With these directions, the Miscellaneous Application is disposed of.
