O R D E R

1. The petitioner challenges the impugned judgment and order dated 12.11.2025 in CRM-M No.62445 of 2025 titled "*Nitin @ Nitin Kumar Vs. State of Haryana*", passed by the High Court of Punjab and Haryana at Chandigarh.
2. Delay condoned.

3. Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner(s), we are of the considered view that interest of justice would be best met with the disposal of the present petition on the following terms:

(i) The trial is in progress. 13 out of 30 cited witnesses already stand examined. Such of those witnesses who stand examined are material witnesses.

(ii) The remaining witnesses are either police officers, who carried out the investigation or other formal witnesses.

(iii) Since the trial is in progress, we direct the parties to fully cooperate; not to seek any unnecessary adjournment and request the Trial Court to consider examining the testimonies of the remaining witnesses at the earliest.

4. Accordingly, the present Special Leave Petition stands disposed of.

5. Pending application(s), if any, shall stand disposed of.
