O R D E R

The petitioner has been convicted for offences punishable under Sections 376 and 302 of the Indian Penal Code and sentenced to death by the trial court, which conviction and sentence has been affirmed by the High Court of Madhya Pradesh, Bench at Gwalior. The present petitions assial the correctness of the said Judgement and Order. The conviction and sentence, it appears is based entirely on circumstantial evidence led by the prosecution. Keeping in view all these aspects, especially, the fact that it is a death sentence case, we deem it fit to refer this case to a Bench of three Judges accordingly direct that the papers be placed before Hon'ble the Chief Justice of India for constituting an appropriate Bench.

The conviction and sentence awarded to the petitioner shall remain stayed pending final disposal of the special leave petitions.
