O R D E R

Although the impugned order is an interim order, we may clarify that each of the Members of

the Association shall, within two weeks, furnish to the Comptroller and Auditor General ['CAG', for short] revenue sharing details/documents. If CAG requires any further information on revenue sharing, the same shall also be supplied by each of the Members of the Association. However, till the hearing and final disposal of the Writ Petition pending in the High Court, which is listed at Serial No.35 in the final hearing list today, no steps shall be taken by CAG to carry out the audit on the basis of the revenue sharing details/documents/information, which is given by each Member of the Association without prejudice to the rights and contentions in the pending Writ Petition. We request the High Court to expeditiously hear and dispose of the Writ Petition. We also make it clear that the Department will file its counter affidavit within one week from today in the pending Writ Petition before the High Court.

The special leave petition is dismissed.
