ORDER

Leave granted.

The High Court suspended the sentence of the appellant

and admitted to bail on the condition that he shall deposit a sum of Rs. 6 lacs which is said to be his civil liability and on his furnishing personal bond in the sum of Rs.20,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the concerned Court. According to the direction issued by the High Court the appellant has already deposited Rs. 3 lacs.

This Court, by Order dated 3.7.2007 has directed the appellant to deposit Rs. 1 lac instead of the balance amount of Rs.3 lacs which was directed to be deposited in the High Court.

In the facts and circumstances of the case, we confirm the order passed by this Court on 3.7.2007 and the Order of the High Court is modified to that extent.
