Issue notice.

By the impugned order, the petitioner was directed by the High Court to deposit a sum of Rs. 6 Lacs, out of which, an amount of Rs. 3 Lacs was ordered to be deposited on or before 24 th May 20 0 7 and the balance amount of Rs. 3 Lacs was ordered to be deposited one month thereafter.

We are informed by learned counsel for the petitioner that the initial amount of Rs. 3 Lacs has already been deposited, as directed by the High Court.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, insofar as the remaining amount of Rs. 3 Lacs is concerned, there will be ad interim stay of deposit of the said amount subject to depositing a further sum of Rs. 1 Lac with the Registr ar General of the High Court within a period of four weeks from this date. In default of the deposit, this interim order shall stand vacated automatically.
