O R D E R

1. Learned Senior counsel appearing for the petitioner(s)/applicant(s) would submit that the High Court, in its order dated 19.03.2024, took note of the role of the Regulating body including, the Serious Fraud Investigation Office (SFIO) and thereafter, directed a CBI Inquiry which has been upheld by this Court vide Order dated 13.05.2024 passed in SLP(Crl.) Diary No.18278/2024 observing that the CBI should proceed to investigate the matter on merit, without directing for investigation by any other authority. However, the SFIO has issued notice to the petitioner(s) in violation of the Order passed by this Court.
2. Issue notice, returnable in eight weeks.
3. Prayer for interim relief shall be considered after notice is served on the respondent(s).
