Considering the peculiar facts and circumstances of this case, we are not inclined to interfere with the impugned order of the National Consumer Disputes Redressal Commission, New Delhi in First Appeal No. 87 of 2013. The Special Leave Petition is dismissed.

However, we grant liberty to the petitioner to move the State Consumer Commission for payment of the dues of the respondents as awarded by the State Consumer Commission in instalments and if such an application is made, the State Consumer Commission may consider the same on its own merits after giving notice to the respondents. The warrants of arrest issued against the petitioners will not be enforced for a period of two weeks from today to enable the petitioners to move the State Consumer Commission for instalments.
