4. Issue notice subject to the condition that the petitioner deposits, as undertaken, a sum of Rs.21,00,000/- (Rupees twenty one lakhs) with the Trial Court on or before 14th May, 2026.

1. Heard Mr. Amol Nirmalkumar Suryawanshi, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner.
2. At the very outset, Mr. Amol Suryawanshi, learned counsel, after obtaining instructions and on the own volition of the petitioner, submits that according to the petitioner, the balance amount payable to the complainant
