## O R D E R

1. SLP (Criminal) No. 1793/2026 filed by the petitioner's co-accused has already been dismissed on 04.02.2026. However, with a view to enabling such co-accused, namely, the petitioner in that case, to join the Court proceedings, it was directed that their arrest shall remain stayed subject to their surrendering before the trial court within two weeks and furnishing adequate bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial court.
2. We see no ground to take a different view in the instant case.

Consequently, the Special Leave Petition is dismissed. The Petitioner's arrest shall remain stayed, subject to his surrendering before the trial court within two weeks and furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial court, along with such other terms and conditions as the Court may deem fit. We clarify that the arrest is being stayed with a view to enabling the petitioner to join the trial court proceedings
