UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

1. After hearing learned counsel for the petitioner, we do not find any merit in the present petition as far as grant of pension to the petitioner is concerned.
2. However, learned counsel for the petitioner has referred to a Memorandum No.F.6-29/83-ESTT.I dated 16th April, 2012 issued by the All India Institute of Medical Sciences, Ansari Nagar, New Delhi to the petitioner asking her to deposit a sum of ₹1,29,178/- on account of

over paid salary from 30th October, 2002 to 31st March, 2003 and for three months' notice period on account of acceptance of her resignation on 23rd May, 2003 w.e.f. 30th October, 2002.

3. The contention raised by the learned counsel for the petitioner with reference to the above communication is that the salary was paid to the petitioner as she was working and second is for the notice period for resignation.

4. Be that as it may, without recording any finding on the aforesaid issues, we direct that whatever amount has already been paid to the petitioner or any amount being claimed on account of notice for resignation as contained in the aforesaid communication of 16th April, 2012 shall not be recovered from the petitioner.

5. In view of the aforesaid, the Special Leave Petition is disposed of.

6. Pending application shall also stand disposed of.
