O R D E R

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that an affidavit dated 29th March, 2005 is filed by Ram Kumar before the High Court in which the deponent has stated that he is not in a capacity to work as Lambardar and he has no objection if the petitioner is allowed to work as Lambardar. He has also expressed his inability since he is working as a teacher, 70 kms. away from the village. The aforesaid affidavit has not been taken into consideration especially keeping in view all the

provisions in Rule 27 of the Punjab Land Revenue Rules, 1909. If that be so, the remedy of the petitioner would lie before the High Court by way of a review petition.

We are not inclined to entertain this special leave petition. The petitioner is at liberty to seek remedy before the High Court.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner prays that he may be permitted to withdraw this special leave petition in view of the observations made by this Court. We order accordingly.
