UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following  
O R D E R

1. Delay condoned.
2. Application for exemption from filing Certified Copy of the Impugned judgment is allowed.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioners has placed reliance on a judgment passed by the same Hon'ble Judge in **United India Insurance Co. Ltd. vs. Darshana & Ors.** (FAO No. 3702 of 2017) against the judgment dated 07.02.2025 wherein the accident was of

27.09.2014 and the deceased was studying in 11<sup>th</sup> standard. However, the Court accepting the earning of Rs.15,000/- per month calculated and awarded a sum of Rs.24,50,000/-.

4. In the present case, the accident is of 21.04.2019. The deceased was studying in 12<sup>th</sup> standard. His earning has been accepted only at Rs.10,500/- per month. There is no reason to take a different view as taken by the Hon'ble Judge in the decision referred to hereinabove.

5. Considering the aforesaid only, we issue notice returnable in six weeks.
