UPON hearing counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

Mr. Altemesh Rein, learned counsel appears for the petitioners. Petitioners also appear before us. They appear to be major and they have been married according to Muslim rites on 25.3.2010 and ever since then they are living as husband and wife. However, on account of this inter caste marriage, respondent No.3, maternal uncle of the girl Yamini Giri, is not happy and is creating hurdles in their living peacefully and happily. They were, therefore, constrained to move the High Court of ....2.

Uttarakhand at Nainital by filing Criminal Writ Petition No.231 of 2010 with a prayer that they should be provided with police protection for some time. However, the Division Bench while passing the impugned order on 31.3.2010 gave liberty to the petitioners to move an appropriate representation before the SSP Nainital, who was directed to consider the said representation.

We have been given to understand that the prayer of the petitioners has not been looked into properly and they are unable to stay at Mirzapur on account of threats which have been extended by respondent No.3.

Keeping all these facts in mind, we direct SSP,  
Mirzapur, District Saharanpur (U.P) to provide them  
police protection initially for a period of 15 days  
hereof.

With the aforesaid direction, this special leave  
petition is disposed of. In case, the SSP finds that  
further protection would be necessary, then he may  
provide the same.
