## O R D E R

2. We have heard learned counsel for the petitioner.

9. The petitioner shall make himself available before the Investigating Officer on 09.04.2026 at 10:00 a.m. and on all such dates as he may be required.

10. Needless to add, till the investigation is not complete in all respects, the petitioner would fully cooperate, and if the challan/charge sheet is filed, he would maintain good conduct and not attempt to influence any of the witnesses in any manner till the completion of the trial.
