UPON hearing counsel the Court made the following  
O R D E R

Issue notice.

The following interim order shall remain operative until further orders :-

(i) The petitioner shall deposit the enhanced amount of compensation as per the impugned judgment with the Reference Court, i.e., the District Judge, Nashik within one month from today.

(ii) Upon deposit of the above amount, the expropriated owners/claimants shall be entitled to withdraw 50% of the enhanced amount by the High Court unconditionally.

(iii) As regards remaining 50% of the enhanced amount, the expropriated owners/claimants shall be entitled to withdraw the same on furnishing solvent surety/security to the satisfaction of the District Judge, Nashik within three months of the intimation of such deposit.

(iv) In case, the expropriated owners/claimants do not furnish solvent surety/security for withdrawal of the 50% of the enhanced amount within the time above noted, the District Judge, Nashik shall invest the said amount in a nationalised Bank initially for a period of one year, renewable thereafter for the same period every time.
