The grievance of the petitioner as  
raised by the learned counsel for the  
petitioner is that the petitioner has been  
convicted under Sections 304B, 498A read with  
Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code and the  
sentence 10 years rigorous imprisonment was

imposed. Out of which he has already served  
about 5 years 2 months approximately.

However, while rejecting the bail  
application, the High court has fixed the  
appeal itself for final hearing.

In case the appeal is not heard and disposed of within a period of six months by the High Court, the petitioner shall be at liberty to revive his bail application and if such an application is filed, the High Court is requested to consider it sympathetically and pass appropriate order in accordance with law.

With these observations, the SLP stands disposed of.
