O R D E R

In these applications, the petitioner has prayed as under -

"direct the State of Punjab to release the funds in respect of enhanced compensation amounting to Rs.42,41,27,924 with interest calculated up to 31.8.2011 and with further interest up till the date of its payment."

We have heard learned counsel for the applicant and perused the record.

In our view, the prayer made by the petitioner is wholly misconceived and there is no warrant for issue of a direction to the State of Punjab to release funds for payment of compensation to the

land owners. It is for the petitioner to take appropriate steps for ensuring payment to the land owners.

With the above observations, the applications are dismissed.
