

2. Notice was issued for the purpose of considering the plea for suspension of substantive order of sentence and release on bail pending the final disposal of the appeal before this Court.

3. Today, when the matter was taken up, none remain present on behalf of the State of Jharkhand.

4. We heard Mr. Somiran Sharma, the learned counsel appearing for the appellant-convict.

5. *Prima-facie*, it appears that the wife of the appellant-convict was in an illicit relationship with one another person.

6. This is a case of double murder.

7. The appellant-convict and his juvenile son are alleged to have hit blows in the midnight hours on the lady and her paramour.

8. We take notice of the fact that the appellant is undergoing life imprisonment past almost 13 years.

9. In the overall view of the matter, we suspend the substantive order of sentence passed by the Trial Court, as affirmed by the High Court and order that the appellant-convict be released on bail, subject to terms and conditions that the Trial Court may deem fit to impose, pending the final disposal of the Criminal Appeal before this Court.
