O R D E R

1. Permission to file Special Leave Petition is granted.
2. While we do not find any ground to interfere with the impugned order granting bail to respondent No.1, we direct the trial court to make an endeavour to conclude the trial proceedings preferably within six months.
3. The State and the petitioner shall be at liberty to move an application before the trial court seeking the addition of one more bail condition, namely, the deposit of the original passport by

respondent No.1 with the trial court. The trial court will pass an appropriate order on that application after hearing the parties.

4. The Special Leave Petition stands disposed of.

5. Pending application(s), if any, shall stand closed.
