O R D E R

1. The petitioner challenges the impugned judgment and order dated 20.01.2026 in Criminal Revision No.4510 of 2025, titled "*Madhur Mishra Vs. State of U.P. & Ors.*", passed by the High Court of Judicature at Allahabad.

2. The petitioner-in-person has been apprised of his legal right to be represented through the legal aid counsel, subject to eligibility, or through the counsel of his choice. However, he has chosen to argue the matter in person.
