UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

1. Delay condoned.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the original Review Mining plan submitted by the petitioner was approved on 25.06.2018 and enured to its benefit for a period of five years. The five-year period was expired on 24.06.2023. It is pointed out that the petitioner submitted the draft application for review on 16.03.2023, which was prior to the expiry of the original plan period.

3. It is evident from the impugned order that this argument was not raised before the High Court. Moreover, in the facts and circumstances of the case, we permit the petitioner to withdraw the instant Special Leave Petition so as to invoke the review jurisdiction of the High Court.

4. Upon filing the review petition, the High Court may consider and dispose of the same on its own merits expeditiously. Liberty is granted to the petitioner to approach this Court, if the need so arises.

5. In view of above, the Special Leave Petition is disposed of as withdrawn, with liberty as aforesaid.
