



months from the date of receipt of the order. If the matter is not disposed of within six months, then the accused may apply fresh application for bail."

Aforesaid order shows that petitioner's

appeal was directed to be disposed of within a period

of six months from the said date.

But it is not yet

been disposed of.

It has also been contended that

petitioner is in jail for the last more than eight

years. It has further been contended that looking to

the ill health of petitioner's mother and minor

daughter, it is desirable that the petitioner should be

released on bail.

On consideration of the facts and features of

the matter, we direct that the petitioner -Sajal Suresh

Kumar Jain be released on interim bail subject to his

furnishing bail bond for a sum of Rs.25,000/- and a

solvent surety of the like amount to the satisfaction

of the Trial Court.
