UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

1. The High Court, while dismissing the Writ Petition preferred by the petitioner before us observed thus:-

"2. The petitioner challenged the impugned communication dated 06.02.2026. It is seen that it is only a consequential intimation pursuant to the earlier order dated 27.01.2026. The said order dated 27.01.2026 issued by the local body was put to challenge in W.P. (MD) No.2646 of

2026. By a very detailed order dated 06.02.2026, the writ petition was dismissed. Without assailing the said order which is holding good, challenging the consequential communication is not maintainable. On this ground alone, we dismiss the writ petition. The writ petition stands dismissed. No costs. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petition is closed."

2. The High Court is right in taking the view that in the absence of challenge to the main order dated 06.02.2026, the subsequent issue of notice as a consequence could not have been challenged.

3. If the petitioner intends to challenge the main order passed in Writ Petition (MD) No.2646/2026, it shall be open for him to do so in accordance with law.
