1. Issue notice.
2. If the petitioner has not been taken into custody despite dismissal of his application for bail by the impugned order passed by the High Court, his liberty shall not be disturbed until further orders.

(iv) if the charge has not been framed, the reason therefor;

(v) if the trial has commenced, the number of witnesses examined;

(vi) criminal antecedents of the petitioner;

(vii) whether any co-accused is enlarged on bail; and

(viii) any other information relevant for a decision on the special leave petition.

4. Rejoinder thereto, if any, be filed within a week thereafter.
