Having heard learned counsel for the parties, we are of the opinion that the

Writ Petitions filed by the Confederation of All Nagaland State Service
Employees'

Association as also by the Government of Nagaland should be agitated a
t the first

instance before the High Court of Judicature at Gauhati in exercise of its power under

Article 226 of the Constitution of India. The pleadings of the parties,
which are

complete, may be sent to the High Court which, upon receipt, shall be
registered as
