Delay condoned.

The petitioner themselves reinstated the respondent after his acquittal by the appellate court. After acquittal, the respondent filed a Writ Petition in the

High Court seeking his reinstatement as a Teller along with arrears of salary and other allowances. The High Court has allowed the Writ Petition. Learned senior counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners states that the departmental proceedings have been initiated against the respondent but the same have been stayed by the High Court in Writ Petition No.5071/2000.

We do not find any infirmity in the Order as such. However, the payment made in pursuance to the directions issued by the High Court in the impugned Order shall be subject to the final outcome of the departmental inquiry initiated against the respondent.

In W.P.No.5071/2000, the High Court has stayed the departmental inquiry. We would request Hon'ble the Chief Justice of the High Court to list Writ Petition No.5071/2000 for final disposal at an early date.

The Special Leave Petitions are disposed of accordingly.
