O R D E R

The petitioner, who appears in person,
submits that as the period of summer vacation for
which he was seeking interim custody of the child
is already over, he would be satisfied if the
costs imposed upon him by the High Court are
waived.

Having perused the record of the case and
bearing in mind the fact that the application
filed by the petitioner was dismissed ex parte,
we feel that the learned Court should not have
imposed heavy costs of Rs.10,000/- on the
petitioner. Accordingly, while permitting the
petitioner to withdraw the Special Leave
Petition, we set aside the direction with regard
to payment of the said costs.

The Special Leave Petition is dismissed as
withdrawn in the above terms.
