O R D E R

Leave granted.

The appellant seeks regular bail in connection with FIR No.20/2023, dated 14.08.2023, registered at Police Station-Cyber, District - Khagaria, Bihar, for the offences punishable under Sections 419, 420, 379, 406, 467, 468, 471, 120-B and 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 66(D) of the Information Technology Act, 2000 and Section 3 of the Bihar Protection of Interest of Depositors (in Financial Establishments) Act, 2002.

We have heard the learned counsel appearing for the parties.

We have taken into consideration the fact that the appellant has been under incarceration for two and a half years approximately. Though, it is submitted by the learned counsel for the respondent-State that the bail application of the co-accused person has been rejected, the fact remains that another co-accused person who is similarly placed as the appellant, has been granted bail by this Court vide order dated 07.01.2026.

We further take note of the prior criminal antecedents, wherein, the appellant was involved which are, in fact, of similar nature. The same will not come in the way of the appellant receiving the benefit of bail.

Considering the aforesaid position, we are inclined to grant bail to the appellant.

Accordingly, the impugned order stands set aside and the appellant is granted bail on the terms and conditions subject to the satisfaction of the concerned Trial Court.

The appeal stands allowed, accordingly.
