O R D E R

The petitioner-wife has filed the present petition under Section 25 of the Code of Civil Procedure seeking transfer of O.P. No. 660 of 2005 titled as Manoj Kumar Gangadharan v. Anjali , instituted by her husband (the respondent herein) under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, which is pending in the Family Court at Thrissur, Kerala to the Family Court at Bhopal (M.P.).

When the case came up for hearing before this Court, notice was issued to the respondent-husband limited to the question as to whether the respondent-husband is willing to pay all travel and stay expenses of the petitioner-wife and a companion on each occasion when she has to attend the Court at Thrissur, Kerala.

Counsel appearing for the respondent-husband, after taking

instructions, states that the respondent-husband shall pay to and fro travel expenses of the petitioner and her companion by a III tier A.C. In addition to the travelling expenses of the petitioner-wife and her companion from Bhopal to Thrissur, the respondent has undertaken to pay to the petitioner for accommodation and stay of the petitioner and her companion. Ordered accordingly.

Subject to the the above directions, the transfer petition is dismissed.
