UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

1. Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that after the petitioner's wife committed suicide on 22.03.2024, the matter was investigated at least 09 times by senior police officers of the rank of Superintendent of Police, Bhiwani, Rohtak, Siwani, Loharu, Kalanaur, and nothing incriminating was found against the petitioner. Thereafter, there was a

compromise between the parties on 06.04.2024 (Annexure-P6) pursuant to which, petitioner has paid Rs. 15,00,000/- (Rupees Fifteen Lacs only) to the complainant's side and the custody of the minor child was given to the family of the petitioner on 09.10.2025.

2. After the matter was almost settled, now the present complaint has been filed by the grandfather of the deceased.

3. Issue notice to the respondent, returnable in eight weeks.

4. Mr. Madhav Sinhal, learned counsel appears on behalf of the respondent-State and accepts notice. He undertakes to file counter-affidavit before the next date of hearing.

5. In the meanwhile, petitioner shall not be arrested in FIR No.101/2025, registered at Police Station Behal, District Bhiwani, for the offence under Sections 323, 498-A, 306, 304-B and 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860.
