O R D E R

1. Delay condoned.

2. A joint application being I.A. No. 96930/2026 has been filed under Article 142 of the Constitution of India in disposed of matter.

3. We are happy to record with satisfaction that the parties have arrived at an amicable settlement.

4. It is submitted that during the course of adjudication of the appeal arising out of SLP(CrI.)No. 6359/2025, the appellant had proposed a settlement for quashing of the FIR by depositing a sum of Rs. 1.86 Crores. But at that point of time, Respondent No. 2 had not agreed to the said proposal. This Court, vide order dated 10.09.2025, allowed the appeal. After the disposal of the appeal, now respondent no.2 agrees to accept the sum of Rs.1.86 Crores, along with interest, as full and final settlement of dispute inter se the private parties.

5. The amount of Rs.1.86 Crores, deposited by the appellant before the Registry of this Court, shall be disbursed to respondent No. 2 along with interest accrued thereupon.

6. In view of the above, we are of the opinion that it is a fit case to invoke Jurisdiction under Article 142 of the Constitution of India and as a consequence thereof, we quash FIR No.287 of 2024, registered at Police Station Ganganagar, District Meerut, Uttar Pradesh against the appellant and all the co-accused as well as Arbitration Case bearing Miscellaneous Civil Application (Arbitration) No.1008 of 2024 before the High Court of Judicature at Bombay, Nagpur Bench.

7. I.A. No. 96930/2026 is allowed.

8. Miscellaneous Application stands disposed of.
