UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

1. Delay condoned.

2. Having heard Dr. S. Muralidhar, learned Senior Counsel for the petitioners and Mr. Kunal Khanna, learned counsel appears on caveat for the respondent(s) and having carefully perused the records including the orders of the learned Single Judge and the Division Bench of the High Court, we are not inclined to interfere with the impugned judgment/order(s).

3. At this stage, Dr. S. Muralidhar, learned Senior Counsel for the petitioners drawing attention to paragraph 17(ii) of the order dated 24.02.2025 passed by the learned Single Judge of the High Court, submits that when the learned Single Judge passed the order, the learned Judge directed that the injunction shall come into effect after lapse of 60 days from the date of receipt of a copy of the order to enable the petitioners herein and defendants in the suit(s) concerned to make necessary amends. Learned Senior Counsel for the petitioners submits that since this Court is disposing of the Special Leave Petitions, time be granted to make necessary amends as was directed by the learned Single Judge of the High Court.

4. This part of the prayer of the learned Senior Counsel for the petitioners is meritorious. We grant three months time from today to make necessary amends so as to give effect to the injunction that is originally passed by the learned Single Judge, confirmed by the Division Bench of the High Court.

5. The Special Leave Petitions are disposed of in the above terms.

6. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
