This petition is filed by the wife for transfer of a divorce petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 filed by the husband from the Court of ADJ-03(NORTH), Tis Hazari Court, Delhi to Family Court, Bokaro (Jharkhand).
