We find no merit in this special leave petition because, as rightly held by the High Court, the notice of demand is not in terms of the bank guarantees. If a notice to the Bank had been written in terms of the bank guarantees, possibly there would have been no difficulty in the encashment thereof. Learned Additional Solicitor General states that a notice dated 15th November, 2000 has already been issued. This is one more reason why we should not interfere in this case. The special leave petition is dismissed.
