O R D E R

1. Delay condoned.
2. We are not inclined to interfere with the impugned judgment and order of the High Court; hence, the special leave petition is dismissed.
3. It is submitted that the petitioner has been behind bars for more than 29 years. Subject to the petitioner acquiring eligibility for pre-mature release in terms of the relevant remission policy of the State of Kerala, the Superintendent of the Correctional Home where the petitioner is lodged shall move the

appropriate Department in the Government for securing such release. An appropriate decision shall be taken by the Department without any delay, once the Superintendent moves on behalf of the petitioner for securing his release.
