O R D E R

1. This appeal is directed against the judgment and order passed by the High Court of Gujarat at Ahmedabad in First Appeal NO.3419 of 2012, dated 06.12.2012.

2. The appellants/claimants are the legal heirs of the deceased, who has met with an accident and succumbed to his injuries. On the claim made by the appellants/claimants, the Motor Accident Claims Tribunal (Main) Kachhchh at Bhuj (for short, "the Tribunal"), had awarded a compensation of Rs.2,18,250/- with interest at the rate of 9 per cent per annum till the date of petition till its realization.

3. Being aggrieved by the compensation so awarded by

before the High Court. The High Court, by its impugned  
judgment and order, has dismissed the appeal filed by the

appellants-herein thereby confirming the award passed by  
the Tribunal. Aggrieved by the judgment and order passed  
by the High Court, the appellants/claimants are before us  
in this appeal.

4. We have heard learned counsel for the appellant.

5. After going through the judgments and orders passed by the Tribunal as well as the High Court and keeping in view the peculiar facts and circumstances of the case, we are of the opinion that without disturbing the orders passed by the High Court, the ends of justice would be met, if we award another sum of Rs.2,00,000/-.

6. Accordingly, while allowing this appeal, we modify the judgments and orders passed by the High Court as well as the Tribunal. The appellants/claimants are now entitled for a sum of Rs.2,00,000/- over and above the order passed by the High Court with interest at the rate of 6 per cent on the enhanced amount from the date of the order passed by the High Court.

7. We clarify that the compensation shall be paid by the respondent No.3 as expeditiously as possible at any rate within a period of six weeks from today, without any deductions whatsoever.

Ordered accordingly.
