UPON hearing counsel the Court made the following

O R D E R

It appears that by reason of the impugned judgment a Division Bench of the Allahabad High Court, while opining that the first respondent herein has wrongly been deprived of the allocation of the petrol pump vis-a-vis the repondent No.2 herein, directed:

"....Accordingly we allow the writ petition and direct the respondent authority to grant licence for petrol pump in favour of the writ petitioner also without

disturbing respondent No.4 considering the fact that respondent No.4 is also widow of war hero and has already started functioning in the petrol pump allotted to her by the authority. Such licence in favour of the writ petitioner should be granted within two months from the date she completes all the formalities."

1 It is not in dispute that the second respondent is operating the petrol pump in question.

In the peculiar facts and circumstances of this case, when we made a query as to whether there is any possibility of compliance of the High Court judgment by the appellant herein, Mr. Puri, learned counsel appearing for the appellant seeks some time to seek instructions in the matter.
