Two rival versions have been putforth by eitherside on the occurrence in the case. Appellant belongs to one side. It was at the instance of the appellant that FIR No.255/2000 had been registered. The accused arrayed in that FIR were released on bail, as told to us by learned counsel for the appellant. It is unnecessary for us to consider whether the prayer for anticipatory bail should be granted to the appellant. We permit the appellant to surrender before the court concerned and apply for bail. If any such application is made the court will release him on bail imposing such conditions as the court deems fit. One condition which shall necessarily be included is that appellant should present himself for interrogation by the investigating officer at such time and place required by the investigating officer. With these directions this appeal is disposed of.
