UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following  
O R D E R

1. The petitioner was arrested in connection with Case Crime No. 923 of 2025 registered with P.S. Kotwali, Deoria, District Deoria, for the offence punishable under Sections 65(2), 115(2) and 351(2), respectively of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 (for short, "the BNS, 2023) and Sections 5 and 6, respectively of the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012 (for short, "the POCSO Act").
2. The Sessions Court rejected the bail application. The High Court granted the bail to the petitioner.
3. The father of the victim being dissatisfied has questioned the legality and validity of the order passed by the High Court granting bail to the petitioner.
4. In such circumstances, the father of the victim is here before

us seeking cancellation of bail.

5. It is not in dispute that the victim is a minor. It is also not in dispute that she was studying in the institute run and managed by the respondent no.2.

6. We want the State to place on record a report highlighting what type of investigation was undertaken, the materials collected in the course of the investigation and other details.
