It is part of the writ petition filed before the High Court, where the petitioner made a specific averment that M/s. Gulab Sweets is neither engaged in any manufacturing activity of sweets nor in the storage of raw materials for such manufacture in the disputed property.

4. Till the next date of hearing, there shall be stay of operation of the impugned order as well as the demand which came to be upheld thereby.
5. However, the petitioner is put on guard that should the respondent-State be successful in persuading us to hold that the aforesaid statement made by him before the High Court is incorrect, it is obvious that he would be liable to consequences and dealt with appropriately.
