This petition is directed against judgment dated 17-01-2011  
of the Division Bench of the Madhya Pradesh High Court whereby  
the Writ Appeal preferred by the petitioners against the order  
of the learned Single Judge allowing the writ petition filed by  
respondent No. 1 was dismissed.

In the first round, the case was passed over at the request  
of some learned counsel. In the second round, no one appeared on  
behalf of the petitioners.

Notwithstanding the above, we have carefully gone through  
the record and are satisfied that the special leave petition is  
liable to be dismissed because the petitioners have deliberately  
omitted to place on record the order passed by the learned  
Single Judge whereby the answer sheets of respondent Nos. 1 & 2  
were sent to Principal, Pandit Lajja Shankar Jha, Government  
Model High School, Jabalpur for valuation by a competent teacher  
of the school.

Even otherwise, we are satisfied with the conclusion recorded by the learned Single Judge and the Division Bench on the merit of respondent No. 1 vis-a-vis respondent No. 2 does not suffer from any legal infirmity requiring interference under Article 136 of the Constitution.

The special leave petition is accordingly dismissed.
