UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

1. This special leave petition is directed against an order dated 27th January, 2026 of the High Court whereby an application for interim relief was directed to be listed after two weeks along with the records.
2. Grievance of the petitioner is that his writ petition¹, instituted in the year 2021, has been listed on more than 40 (forty) occasions but the High Court, for some reason or the other, has not been able to decide the application for interim relief even, not to speak of rendering a final decision on the writ

petition.

3. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that even after the impugned order is passed, the writ petition was listed but could not be taken up for consideration despite a prayer citing urgency having been made.

4. If indeed what the petitioner claims is true, we would request the roster Bench of the High Court to at least decide his application for interim relief as early as possible and positively within a month from date.

5. In the event, the claim is found to be unsubstantiated, we leave it open to the High Court to deal with the writ petition appropriately.

6. The special leave petition stands disposed of.

7. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
