O R D E R

These petitions are directed against orders dated 27.02.2013 and 16.05.2013 by which the Division Bench of the Punjab and Haryana High Court dismissed the writ petitions filed by the petitioners for quashing the acquisition of their land.

After making some submissions and realising that the Court is not inclined to entertain the special leave petitions, learned counsel for the petitioners made a request that their clients may be permitted to withdraw the special leave petitions with liberty to avail appropriate remedies.

The request of the learned counsel is accepted and the special leave petitions are dismissed as withdrawn with liberty in terms of the prayer made.

However, it is made clear that the liberty given to the petitioners to pursue other remedies shall not be construed as a mandate of this Court to any authority or Court to entertain the prayer made by the petitioners and the application, if any, filed in this regard shall be dealt with and decided on its own merits keeping in view the fact that the writ petitions filed by the applicants have already been dismissed.
