The appellant has been convicted by Additional Sessions Judge for having committed the murder of his wife and two sons and for making an attempt to commit the murder of his daughter. For offence under Section 302 IPC he has to undergo life imprisonment besides fine and for offence under Section 307 IPC he has to undergo rigorous imprisonment of 7 years besides fine. The High Court on re-appreciation of evidence has reached the same conclusion as reached by Additional Sessions Judge and has confirmed the conviction and sentence.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties, we find no infirmity in the impugned judgment and order of the High Court. The appeal is meritless and is accordingly dismissed.
