It is surprising notwithstanding the order of this Court dated 7.12.2001, neither the petitioners have surrendered nor the State has arrested them. On 1.4.2002 the counsel appearing for the State had undertaken that the order of the Court directing arresting of the accused persons will be complied within four weeks from today. Inaction on the part of the State indicates that the State is colluding with the accused persons, who have been granted pardon pursuant to some orders of the Government of Uttar Pradesh, which orders have been annulled by Allahabad High Court. The order has not been complied with till today. As a last chance, we grant four weeks time from today to the State Government to comply with the Court's order and also to file an affidavit why there has been inaction on the part of the State Government so far. The Director General of Police, State of U.P. should be present in the Court on the next date of hearing.
