



the consent of learned counsel for the parties.

Leave granted.

This appeal by special leave is directed against the order dated 12th March, 2009 passed by the National Consumer Disputes Redressal Commission, New Delhi in Revision Petition No.605 of 2009 whereby the revision petition filed by the appellants herein has been dismissed and the order of the District Forum as well as that of the State Commission have been affirmed. The District Forum

had directed the refund of consideration amount with interest at the rate of 18% per annum thereon. Besides this compensation of Rs.15,000/- and cost of Rs.2,000/- was also awarded. The appeal against the said order was dismissed by the State Commission.

In view of the concurrent findings of the fora below, we are not interfering with the merits of the case. However, we direct that the interest of 18% per annum awarded by the District Forum shall be reduced to 9% per annum.

With these observations this appeal is disposed of.
