Application for exemption from filing a certified copy of the impugned order is allowed.

Delay condoned.

We find that the High Court proceeded on the assumption that the order dated 17.07.2015 of the District Collector was not challenged. This assumption was contrary to the facts, as the said order was challenged before the High Court and, by order dated 11.08.2015 passed in Writ Petition No. 22594-22607/2015, the High

Court set aside the said order.

Further, we find that the petitioner's writ petition was not only dismissed but an adverse order was passed against them to the effect that they should be evicted within 12 weeks.

Issue notice, returnable on 27.07.2026.

Notice shall be served by all modes, including *dasti*.

Operation of the impugned order passed by the High Court shall remain stayed till the next hearing.
