UPON hearing counsel the Court made the following
ORDER

As it is against an interim order, we are not inclined to interfere with the same,
especially, when a similar interim order was against some other institution which was
impugned before this Court and the same was dismissed by this Court. However, we notice
that the Division Bench has stayed the operation of a legislation passed by the State

Government namely, Educational Institutions (Reservation

for Scheduled Caste, Scheduled Tribes and Other Backward Classes Act, 2006. We request the High Court to dispose of the matter pending before it at an early date.

Learned counsel for the State points out that some of the colleges have agreed to implement the policy of reservation in their institutions. If there is any such agreement between the State and such institutions, the State can take further steps in this regard.

The Special Leave Petition is disposed of accordingly. No costs.
